Emergency Travel Certificate

As the name implies, Emergency Travel Certificate is issued for emergency purposes only, when and if the standard passport is lost. ETCs are issued to facilitate applicants immediate departure for Nigeria only.

- Police Report stating the loss of a Nigerian Passport.
- Passport photographs of the applicant.
- Original and photocopy of the return ticket to Nigeria.
- Payment of the fee of £33.00 after interview.
- Completion of application forms for ETC (supplied after interview)
- Presentation of photocopies of pages 1-5 of Guarantor's valid Nigerian passport and the data page; pages 32/33 if EEC passport type
- 2 Utility bills of the guarantor or the invitee.
- Postage services are not acceptable.
- Air ticket to Nigeria.
