Issue of passport to a Child of five years and above (First Issue)

- Completion of Form C1;
- Letter of consent from both parents. In case of single parenthood, show proof;
- Photocopies of data page of parents' passport must be attached to the application form;
- Photocopy of the child's long birth certificate;
- Two studio-taken passport size photographs of the applicant;
- Payment of:
 - i. *For children whose names are previously endorsed on parent's passport, £39 in Postal Order made payable to the Nigeria High Commission, London or by Credit/Debit card.*

OR

- ii. *For children whose names are not endorsed on parent's passport, £54 in Postal Order made payable to the Nigeria High Commission London or by Credit/Debit card;*

AND

- Submission of Guarantors Form (P. 21) sworn before the Commissioner of Oaths of Nigeria High Commission;
- Application must be submitted in person or by post through special delivery (including return postage);

(PAYMENT BY CASH OR CHEQUE IS NOT ACCEPTABLE).
